DESCRIPTION

Dow Corning[®] 3-6891 One-Part Silicone Rubber Abradable Sealant Compound is a black, one-part abradable material that cures with heat to become a flexible rubber. Compared to other silicone products, it has the following unique combination of features:

- Low density
- High temperature stability
- High abradability/machinability

These features are particularly suited for the product's use as an abradable seal and rubstrip for the compressor blades of jet engines, as well as for high-temperature thermal insulation. The product meets United Technologies Pratt & Whitney specification PWA 36447.

HOW TO USE Surface Preparation

Surfaces should be clean, dry and free of contaminants, oils, finger prints and release agents. A two-step cleaning procedure is generally recommended. First, clean off any oil/grease type contaminants with a good grease cutting solvent such as *Dow Corning*[®] OS-10, OS-20 or OS-30 Fluid, naphtha, mineral spirits or toluene. Second, wipe the surface with methanol, isopropyl alcohol or acetone and allow to dry.

When using any solvent, always provide adequate ventilation and follow all

handling precautions on the Material Safety Data Sheet provided by the solvent supplier and the container label.

To obtain good adhesion, surfaces should be primed with *Dow Corning*[®] P5200 Adhesion Promoter. Refer to the product information sheet for detailed use and handling instructions. Apply a very thin coating of the primer (wiping on with a clean cloth and then immediately wiping off any excess primer with another clean cloth works well). The primer should be allowed to cure for one to two hours at about 72°F and a minimum 20 percent relative humidity. Lower temperatures or humidities may require longer primer cure times.

Application

Dow Corning 3-6891 One-Part Silicone Rubber Abradable Sealant Compound can be cast, troweled or injected into place using standard one-component processing equipment. A typical schedule for jet engine use cures the material for two hours at 300°F. Lower temperatures may require additional time to reach full cure.

Imperfections in moldings may be repaired by cutting away the defective areas, applying fresh *Dow Corning* 3-6891 One-Part Silicone Rubber Abradable Sealant Compound to the clean surface, and heat curing as indicated above. New material forms a homogenous bond with the underlying rubber.
