#### **Precautionary Statements**

Storage:

Prevention: Keep away from heat, sparks, open flames, hot surfaces - no smoking. Keep container tightly

closed. No release into water. Use explosion-proof equipment. Use only non-sparking tools. Take precautionary measures against static discharge. Avoid breathing vapors, mist, or spray. Wash affected area thoroughly after handling. Use only outdoors or in a well-ventilated area.

## 4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Inhalation: Move to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration. If breathing is

difficult, give oxygen. Get medical attention.

Skin contact: Immediately flush skin with plenty of water (using soap, if available). Remove

contaminated clothing and footwear. Get medical attention. Wash clothing

before reuse. Thoroughly clean shoes before reuse.

Eye contact: Rinse immediately with plenty of water, also under the eyelids, for at least 15

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## 5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

## 6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES
